### About Us

We meet the needs of safe data access professionals working in these diverse settings.

### SDAP - achievements at a glance

From 2020 to the end of 2023, the SDAP network has grown across all areas. In particular, 2023 has been a successful year for SDAP with **significant growth** in membership development, engagement and reach, alongside policy development and business planning.

##### SDAP Membership Network from 2020 to 2023:

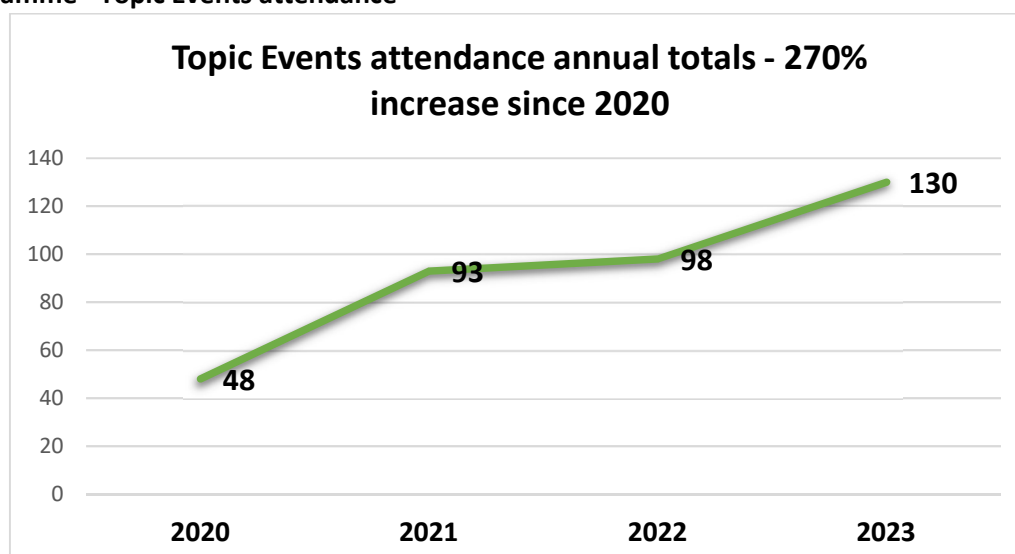
- 3.5 fold increase in individual members

##### 2023 comparison with 2022:

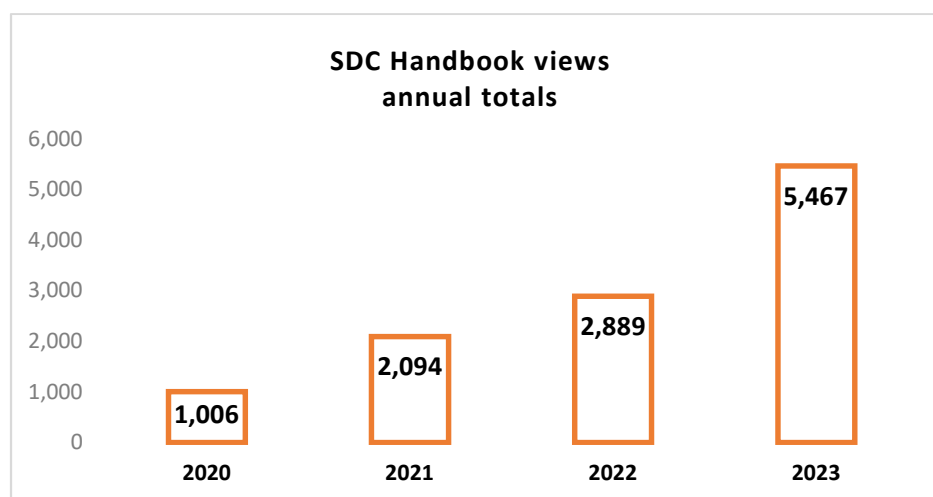
- 40% increase in individual members

#### Member Programme - Topic Events attendance

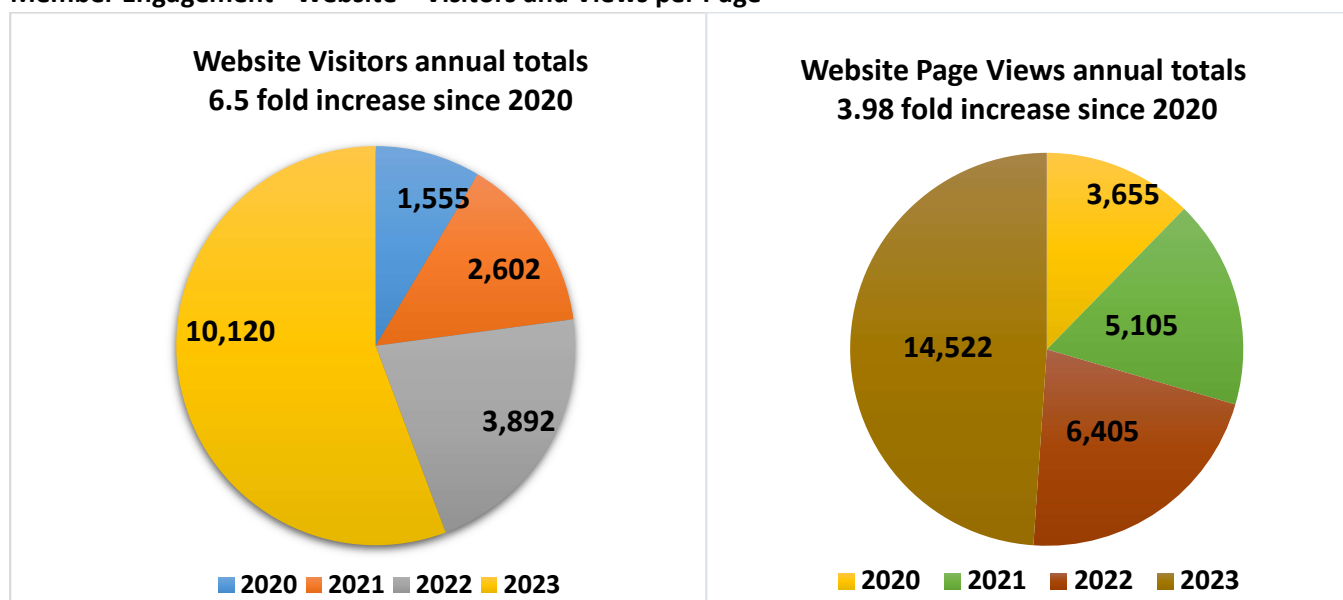


**Member Programme – Guides and Resources - Statistical Disclosure Control Handbook**

**Our SDAP network meetings have reflected on the following topics over the last two years:**

Providing safe setting users with access to synthetic data.	Researcher management during output checking process.
Setting up a remote services (alongside a safe centre operation).	Technical controls used in the disclosure control of machine learning model outputs.
Exploration of how authentication and authorisation infrastructure (AAI) can facilitate international researchers accessing UK data.	Technical infrastructure for secure data access; anonymization (beyond just outputs).
Trusted Research Environments (TRE's) evolution of standards/progression through different accreditation standards (e.g. ISO, NHS Toolkit and DEA).	Office for National Statistics (ONS) Integrated Data Service. Role of HDR UK Innovation Gateway in providing a single point of access to a range of data.

**Working Together – across our member work programme and governance:**

**Membership Network**

We reviewed our membership criteria, ethos and values – that all members collaborate and cooperate in working together to create a supportive network based on 'trust, goodwill and integrity'. We consolidated our commitment to a membership culture based on respect and dignity characterised by 'equality, diversity and inclusivity' by devising our **Membership Code of Conduct** after consulting widely with our network members in 2022.

**Steering Group**

We plan all our work through conferring and consulting with the Steering Group, a group of **eight** SDAP members, who bring a broad and strategic understanding of the sector. In 2023 we finalised our strategic planning through an Action Plan for the next five years.

Pre-funding comparator taken from the end of December 2020 – total member organisations = 18

Post-funding comparator data taken from the end of December 2023 – total member organisations = 40

% growth rate of 35% compared to 2022 and, from 2020, a fold increase of 1.22.

Overall growth from 2018 to 2023 of 500% or a fold increase of 5.

**Individual Members**

Pre-funding comparator taken from the start of January 2021 – total individual members = 44

Post-funding comparator data taken from the end of December 2023 – total individual members = 95

% growth rate of 70% compared to 2022 and, from 2020, a fold increase of 3.5

Overall growth from 2018 to 2023 of 1,055% or 10.5 fold increase.
